

PUBLIC AND CONSERVATION (P-C) District

PC

A district in which the primary use of land is reserved for flood control, future thoroughfare rights-of-way, public recreation, community facility sites, forests and other similar open spaces which will encourage the continued use of land for conservation purposes.

- Construction Office, Temporary
- Temporary Land Clearing
- Real Estate Offices, Temporary
- Temporary Events (Special Event)
- Yard Sales, Residential and Civic

Lot Dimensions

Minimum Lot Size 5 acres

Minimum Lot Width NA

Minimum Lot Frontage 100 feet

Maximum Building Height 40 feet

Principal Structure Setbacks

Front Setback 40 feet

Side Setback 15 feet

Side Setback (Corner) 25 feet

Rear Setback 30 feet

Accessory Building Setback

Front Setback 40 feet

Side Setback 10 feet

Side Setback (Corner) 20 feet

Rear Setback 10 feet
