CARTHAGE, NC: Moore County Public Safety Officials continue to monitor Crystal Lake in Lakeview community just south of Vass North Carolina. Currently, no water is flowing over the dam or roadway. In an effort to lower the water levels of the lake and reduce pressure from the dam, all spillway gates are open and releasing water in a controlled manner in consultation with the North Caroling Dam Safety Inspector. Officials continue to monitor the low-lying areas below the dam for flooding. Residents should take precautions and continue to monitor the condition of the dam.

Emergency Shelter Operations will open on Monday, July 7, 2025, at 7:00 PM located at the Moore County Agricultural Center 707 Pinehurst Ave., Carthage NC 28327.

We encourage citizens to continue to be aware of flooding across the County. During the nighttime, flooded roadways are difficult to see. If you approach these conditions “Turn Around Don’t Drown.”
