This application must be filled out and submitted to Moore County Environmental Health (MCEH) to provide information about any expected food vendors at a special or temporary event in Moore County. This application must be filled out by the event organizer, not individual food vendors. This form is informational only. There is no fee associated with this application. Please include a map/layout of the event showing food vendor locations. Applications can be e-mailed to: mcappleh@moorecountync.gov

Please note:

- Temporary food vendors are required to submit the Temporary Food Establishment (TFE) application separately at least 15 days before the start of the event and pay the \$75.00 TFE permit fee for each selling location.
- North Carolina-permitted mobile food units (MFU's), food trucks, food trailers, and pushcarts may be required to obtain a TFE permit from MCEH depending on the duration of the event.
- Out-of-state-permitted mobile food units, food trucks, food trailers, pushcarts, and caterers MUST contact MCEH to determine if a TFE Permit is needed.
