Town of Carthage 4396 15-501 Hwy 910-947-2331	All signs must be outside street right-of-way, or at least 3 feet from the edge of the pavement. Signs shall not interfere/obstruct safe sight distances at intersections. Not to be placed on private property without consent of owner. Must not exceed 16 sq.ft, max 6 ft high. Cannot be placed until 30 days prior to start of One Stop. May be placed 30 days prior to run-off election or election day following a primary and removed again within 10 days after election run-off.	30 days prior to start date of One-Stop voting/ 10th day after primary or election day.

Village of Pinehurst 395 Magnolia Rd 910-295-1900	Not to exceed 6 sq ft; Max height 4 ft; not to be placed on rights of way, not within ten feet of the edge of pavement	30 days prior to beginning date of "one-stop" voting / 10 days
Town of Robbins 101 N Middleton St 910-948-2431	Not to exceed 32 sq ft in area; private property only	30 days prior to "One Stop voting" / 7 days
Town of Southern Pines 125 SE Broad St 910-692-7021	During the period beginning on the 30th day before the beginning date of early voting for a primary, general, or special election, an unlimited number of signs may be placed on private property. The maximum allowable Sign area of each such Sign shall be six (6) square feet. Each Sign shall be located on private property but in no case shall a sign be allowed closer than ten (10) feet to the paved portion of a road or ten (10) feet from the edge of the travel portion of a non-paved road and may not be attached to a tree or other living plant material. Such Signs must be removed within ten (10) days following the election day for which the Signs are intended to serve. If the period of time between a primary and a general or special election for which the primary is serving is less than four (4) weeks, measured from the date of the primary voting day to the date of the general or special election voting day, the Signs shall be allowed to remain in place. Such Signs may be erected at officially designated polling places on the day of the election.	30 days prior to early voting / 10 days

Village of Whispering Pines 10 Pine Ridge Dr 910-949-3141	Max is 3 sq ft; max height is 4 ft above grade; Max 5 signs per property ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY, CONTACT WHISPERING PINES VILLAGE.	None designated
