



MOORE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
April 5, 2016 Regular Meeting – Highlights

- Proclaimed April as Child Abuse Prevention Month
- Proclaimed April as Public Health Month
- Approved minutes and budget amendments
- Called a public hearing on April 19, 2016 at 5:30pm regarding a request for a conditional use district rezoning of ParIDs 00034424, 00034425, 20060568, and 20060569 from RA-40 to RA-CUD use “solar collector facility”
- Rejected bids received for RFP # 2016-07 for internet service provider
- Authorized contract with Globe Communications for fiber installation
- Authorized issuance of general obligation refunding bonds
- Approved final change order with Terry’s Plumbing for the 2013 water sources project, reducing contract price by \$69,291.75, and agreed to assess liquidated damages in the amount of \$15,000
- Approved submission of final reporting forms to the NC Rural Economic Development Center for the Midland Rd. waterline upgrade project
- Approved contract with Hydrostructures, P.A. in the amount of \$68,477.50 for interceptor sewer inspection and cleaning
- Rescheduled May 17, 2016 regular meeting to May 19, 2016
- Directed County Attorney to prepare a resolution stating the Board’s support of a bill restricting use of the proposed quarter cent local option sales tax for Moore County to public school construction purposes only, and requesting the ballot question, in addition to specifying the use of the funds, clearly state the amount of the tax as one quarter of one percent
- Reappointed Mary Meindl, Jane Robinson, and Leah Brennan to the Nursing and Adult Care Home Community Advisory Committee, and appointed new members Lesa Riddle and Sandra Nusbaum
- Reappointed Bruce Robson to the RSVP Advisory Council
- Reappointed Max Muse to the Board of Health
