November 17, 2015 Regular Meeting – Highlights**

- Proclaimed November as Adoption Awareness Month
- Received quarterly fiscal report for Sandhills Center for Mental Health/Developmental Disabilities/Substance Abuse Services
- Approved on consent agenda: minutes, budget amendments, tax releases/refunds, Register of Deeds fee schedule amendment, Transportation Services fee schedule amendment, Moore County Schools digital learning invoices, and project budget ordinance and resolution for Airport project
- Held a public hearing regarding a Conditional Use Permit request for a veterinary clinic and approved the permit
- Called a public hearing on December 8, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. regarding closeout of the 2012 Scattered Site Housing Community Development Block Grant
- Approved contract amendment with Village of Pinehurst for fire protection, rescue, and medical response
- Approved change order # 4 with Terry's Plumbing for the 2013 water resources project

- Approved amendment to nonprofit grant agreement with Sandhills Center
- Adopted resolution calling a special advisory referendum concerning the levy of a one-quarter cent County sales and use tax
