



**MOORE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**March 19, 2019 Regular Meeting – Highlights**

- Sitting as East Moore Water District Board of Directors, approved minutes and revised EMWD Water and Wastewater System Development Ordinance
- Adopted resolution honoring Cpl. Ralph Holder and requested the NC Board of Transportation to name a bridge in his honor
- Recognized Carthage Buggy Festival and Cameron Antiques Festival for being named by the Southeast Tourism Society as two of the Top 20 events for the month of May
- Received update on Cross Connection Control Program and authorized staff to compose a response to a Moore County Homebuilders Association letter advising the MCHBA that the County intends to enforce the Moore County Cross Connection Control Ordinance
- Approved on consent agenda: minutes, tax releases/refunds, budget amendments, resolutions authorizing the upset bid process for LRK #s 20000203 and 00050614, revised deed for Seven Lakes South well site LRK # 00026840, board order for conditional use permit for tractor equipment repair shop, Ft. Bragg/Moore County mutual/automatic aid agreement renewal
- Approved revised Fire Commission Rules of Procedure
- Held a quasi-judicial hearing for a Conditional Use Permit request for a tourist home, 148 Rice Road, Vass and approved the permit
- Held a public hearing for a conditional rezoning request from Rural Agricultural (RA) to Neighborhood Business Conditional Zoning (B-1-CZ), 1504 North Moore Road, Robbins and approved the rezoning
- Adopted resolution making certain findings and determinations regarding installment financing of a public school project (new gym and classroom additions at North Moore High School) and called a public hearing regarding the same on April 16, 2019 at 5:30pm
- Approved contract for purchase of a 2020 Mack roll-off truck chassis
- Approved contract for Virginia Road water main replacement
- Approved revised Water and Wastewater System Development Ordinance for Moore County Public Utilities
- Approved contract for manhole replacement project
- Adopted resolution regarding Moore County Schools projects related to the general obligation bonds
