September 6, 2016 Regular Meeting – Highlights

- Proclaimed September 2016 as National Recovery Month in Moore County
- Recognized members of the current Dog Tags of Moore County class
- Received quarterly fiscal report for Sandhills Center for Mental Health/Developmental Disabilities/Substance Abuse Services
- Approved on consent agenda: minutes, budget amendments, Moore County Schools digital learning invoices, Register of Deeds fee schedule amendment, Library fee schedule amendment, Library Card Sign-Up Month proclamation, Century Link contract renewal, Microsoft Enterprise agreement, Memorandum of Understanding between Moore County GIS and Public Works, FY 17 Home and Community Care Block Grant, one-time funds augmentation for RSVP, resolution authorizing upset bid process for BLK M 13 Lot 22, grant agreement with Communities in Schools, grant agreement with Sandhills Center
- Held public hearing regarding a Conditional Use Permit request by Williams Sand and Clay, LLC for the use of a sand mine and approved the permit
- Accepted Deed of Dedication for utilities for the Meadows at Farm Life Phase 3 subdivision
- Adopted resolution acknowledging receipt of an offer of \$350,000 for the “Bengston property” and authorizing the upset bid process
- Appointed Eddie Thomas to the Firefighters Relief Fund Board for Seven Lakes
- Appointed Erik Stromberg as the chief representative of the West region on the Fire Commission
- Reappointed Commissioner Graham to the DSS Board
- Appointed Barry Lerman to the Airport Authority
- Approved increases for the Board’s direct reports as follows: Tax Administrator – 1%, Clerk – 1.5%, Attorney – 2%, Manager – 2.5%
