The commissioners on August 2nd approved an engineering agreement with McGill Associates for the Vass Phase 2 Wastewater Collection System Expansion project. This proposed project is intended to complete the sewer service to the large unsewered area within Vass. The contract approved on the 2nd is for study and report phase services and income surveys required to complete funding applications to USDA Rural Development and CDBG.
