Our News

Commissioner Gregory Resignation



Commissioner Louis Gregory resigned from the Board of Commissioners effective February 16, 2022, due to health reasons. Commissioner Gregory had served since December 2016 and was serving his second year as Vice Chairman of the Board. He will be greatly missed.

Work Sessions

The Board held two work sessions in February. The focus of the first meeting held on February 9 was ARP and CSLFRF funding. Commissioners received information from a representative of the School of Government regarding the funds and had the opportunity to ask questions. They also received presentations from the IT and Public Works Directors regarding projects to be potentially addressed by the funds. The focus of the February 23 work session was the County's Strategic Plan. Consultant Deb Manzo led the discussion as commissioners gave their input. The Board also heard from the Public Safety Department, Sheriff's Office, and Solid Waste Department regarding examples of their goals and measures. A third work session to focus on the FY 23 budget is planned for March 9.
