A public hearing regarding the proposed Fiscal Year 2022 budget was held during the Board's regular meeting on June 15 and the budget ordinance was subsequently adopted in a special meeting held June 17.

The budget prioritizes education, public safety, and health and human services. It maintains the County General Tax Rate at .510 per \$100 of valuation, maintains the Advanced Life Support Rate at .04 per \$100 of valuation, and increases the Single Rural Fire Protection Service Rate by one penny from .095 to .105 per \$100 of valuation. The budget is balanced at \$180,183,862 gross and \$170,109,247 net (less transfers and assessments).
