Nick Picerno Rejoins the Board



Former commissioner Nick Picerno has rejoined the Board of Commissioners as the appointee to the District II seat left vacant by Louis Gregory. Commissioner Picerno previously served two terms, from 2008 to 2016, and as chairman of the board. Since returning on March 1, he has already been assigned as the Board's legislative liaison and has been elected as the District 10 Director for the NC Association of County Commissioners.

Courthouse Groundbreaking

The commissioners officially broke ground on the new courthouse project prior to their regular meeting on March 15. Although the project was already underway, the ceremony provided opportunity to celebrate all the hard work that has gone into bringing it to fruition. In addition to the commissioners and staff, several members of the Courthouse Facilities Advisory Committee, and law enforcement and court officials were present.



Budget Meetings
