

#### S727 Moving Along



Senate Bill 727, *An Act to Modify Permissible Uses of the Quarter Cent Local Option Sales Tax for Moore County*, was filed April 25th, passed its first reading and was referred to the State and Local Government Committee, out of which it was reported favorably

and referred back to the Committee on Finance on May 17th. It will be heard in the Committee on Finance at 10:00a.m. on Tuesday, May 31st. The bill is sponsored by Sen. Jerry Tillman and restricts the use of the Article 46 sales and use tax proceeds in Moore County to public school construction purposes only.
