BUDGET ON TRACK TO BE ADOPTED JUNE 16TH

County Manager Wayne Vest presented the [fiscal year 2016 recommended budget](#) to the Board on May 5th. The recommended budget is balanced at \$130,354,514 for all County operations and debt service requirements, which is a 0.59% increase as compared to the fiscal year 2015 adopted original budget.

The Manager's guiding principles in the development of the budget were: 1) To maintain the current County General and ALS tax rates; 2) To identify expense reductions and ensure effective position allocations; 3) To ensure an appropriate level of services for Moore County's citizens; and 4) To

preserve the employee compensation package including a potential cost of living adjustment and sustaining the County's self-insurance program.

A public hearing on the budget was held on May 19th and the Board is expected to adopt the budget on June 16th.

CPR SAVES!



During the May 19th regular meeting, the commissioners recognized recipients of the “CPR Save” Award. These awards are presented annually to staff, volunteers, and response agencies for successful cardio-pulmonary resuscitations.

According to Moore County’s Public Safety Director Bryan Phillips, many EMS agencies give the award to their members when a patient revived with CPR survives long enough to be admitted to a floor room of a hospital. The standard for the award in Moore County is

higher, however, requiring that the patient survives long enough to be released from the hospital.

Director Phillips shared that cardiac arrests are one of the most trying, difficult, and exhausting calls faced by EMS personnel. A successful cardio-pulmonary resuscitation can require tremendous effort and is also a tremendous example of the attainment of the Public Safety Department’s goal—the preservation of human life.
