MCTC Meetings Continue

The Moore County Transportation Committee (MCTC), chaired by Commissioner Jerry Daeke, met on October 26th to discuss the first draft of the Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) highway map, including projects shown and potential changes. The MCTC is on track to have a recommended plan by early next year. A community survey regarding the CTP will be available on the County's website beginning November 1st.



UDO Updated



On October 18th, the commissioners approved a rewrite of the County's Unified Development Ordinance (UDO). The UDO was initially adopted by the Board in February 2014 and combined land use regulations into one document. Staff was directed in March 2015 to rewrite and reorganize the document to make it simpler, shorter, and reader-friendly. This was accomplished in-house largely due to the efforts of Senior Planner Theresa Thompson. She rewrote the document with the support of the rest of the Planning staff, who maintained the rest of the workload. Theresa was recognized by the commissioners on the 18th following their adoption of the UDO and she was presented a gift by the Chairman for her dedication. 
Outgoing Commissioners to be Honored Nov. 15th
