

Notice of Meeting

The Moore County Board of Elections will conduct a public meeting on Monday, June 27, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. in the Auditorium of the Moore County Agricultural Building, 707 Pinehurst Avenue, Carthage, NC to allow the citizens of Moore County the opportunity to offer comments and suggestions on the 2016 General Election One-Stop Plan to be developed for Moore County.

In keeping with the Board's public comment policy, all comments and suggestions addressed to the Board during this Special Meeting shall be subject to the following procedures:

1. This Special Meeting will be limited to one (1) hour.
2. Persons who wish to address the Board will register, in person, on a sign-up sheet available at the door leading into the auditorium of the Moore County Agricultural building. Sign-up sheets will be available beginning 45 minutes before the start of the meeting.
3. Each person signed up to speak will have three (3) minutes to make his/her remarks. In the event there are more than twenty (20) persons signed up to speak, time will be allotted to each speaker to ensure an equal amount of time.
4. No time will be yielded to a speaker by another speaker. If there are several persons together representing a political party or special interest group, a spokesperson for the group should be chosen.
5. Speakers will be acknowledged by the Board in the order in which their names appear on the sign-up sheet. Speakers will begin their remarks by stating their name and address, whether they are residents of Moore County and, if applicable, the political party or group they represent.
6. **Speakers must submit ALL comments or suggestions in writing to the Board. The written documentation must also contain the name and address of the speaker.**
7. All comments or suggestions must be relevant only to Moore County Board of Elections.
8. Those in attendance will refrain from applauding or personal conversation. Those unable to refrain or remain quiet will be asked to leave.
9. Speakers shall not discuss matters which concern the candidacy of any person seeking public office, including the candidacy of the person addressing the Board or matters which are political or partisan in nature.
10. Speakers will address all comments to the Board as a whole and not one individual board member. Discussions between speakers and members of the audience will not be allowed.

Speakers will be courteous in their language and presentation. Matters or comments which are harmful, discriminatory or embarrassing to any citizens, official or employee of Moore County shall not be allowed. Speaker must be respectful and courteous in their remarks and must refrain from personal attacks and the use of profanity.

No action on the 2016 General Election One Stop Plan will be taken by the board during this meeting.
