Moore County Health Department Novel H1N1 Flu Vaccinations

The Health Department will complete its H1N1 school vaccination project on Thursday, December 17, 2009. Moore County school children, from kindergarten through twelfth grade, were vaccinated in Moore County Schools, charter schools and participating private schools.

Since the demand for vaccine for the initial target groups (as identified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, CDC) has been met, the H1N1 flu vaccine is now available for everyone interested in receiving it.

If you are interested in receiving an H1N1 immunization at the Moore County Health Department or if your child did not receive a vaccination at their school, two clinics are currently scheduled. The first will be on **Friday, December 18, 2009 from 2:00 pm to 6:30 pm**. The second clinic will be on **Thursday, January 7, 2010 from 2:00 pm to 6:30 pm**. The Health Department is located at 705 Pinehurst Avenue in Carthage. No appointments are necessary. There will be no charge for the vaccinations. Additional clinics will be scheduled as needed.
