ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES

Moore County Emergency Services responds to an average of 13,000 calls annually. All calls are 911 and are transported locally with no inter-facility transports, no scheduled or back transport to medical facilities or patient residence. This position performs skilled work including patient assessment, interpretation of EKGs and administration of I.V. fluids and drugs, and advanced airway procedures; works in accordance with established medical protocols and under the general direction of the EMS Major.

- Thorough knowledge of the street and road system and physical layout of the county

- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with physicians, associates, patients and their families, other emergency service agencies, and the general public
- Ability to keep records and prepare reports

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

This is heavy work requiring the exertion of 100 pounds of force occasionally, up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and up to 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects; work requires climbing, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, grasping, and repetitive motions; vocal communication is required for expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word, and conveying detailed or important instructions to others accurately, loudly, or quickly; hearing is required to perceive information at normal spoken word levels, and to receive detailed information through oral communications and/or to make fine distinctions in sound; visual acuity is required for depth perception, color perception, night vision, peripheral vision, preparing and analyzing written or computer data, visual inspection involving small defects and/or small parts, use of measuring devices, operation of machines, operation of motor vehicles or equipment, determining the accuracy and thoroughness of work, and observing general surroundings and activities; the worker is subject to inside and outside environmental conditions, noise, vibration, hazards, atmospheric conditions, and wearing a respirator; the worker may be exposed to bloodborne pathogens and may be required to wear specialized personal protective equipment.
