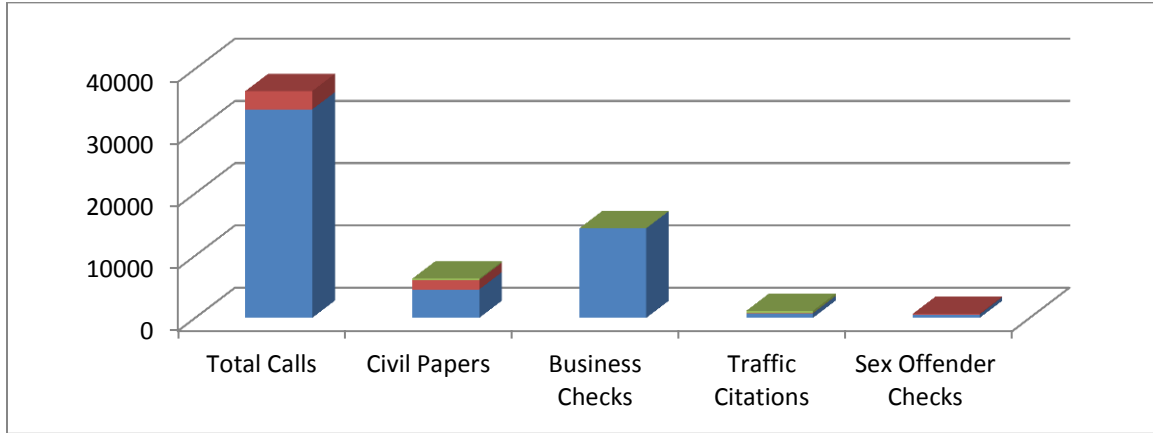

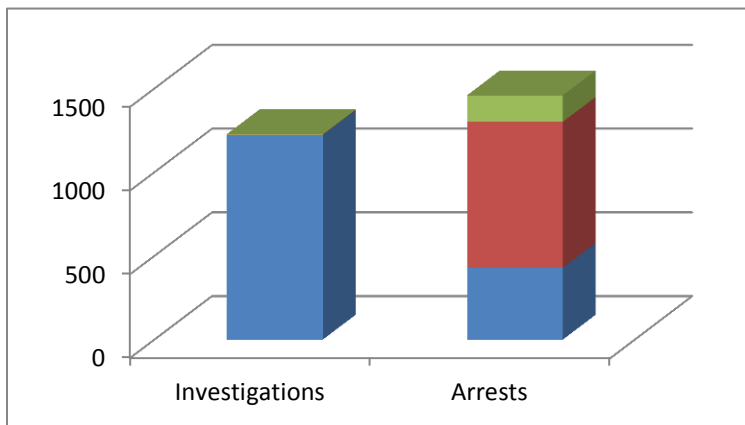


2016 Annual Report



During 2016 our Patrol Deputies averaged ten minutes and five seconds while responding to 33,483 calls for service. They served 4,543 civil and 1,529 criminal papers which included: 206 domestic violence orders, made 867 arrests, conducted 14,398 business checks and transported 82 mental patients. Deputies issued 730 traffic citations: 27 citations for driving while impaired, 112 citations for driving with a revoked license and 386 for speeding in excess of 15 miles per hour over the posted speed limit. Sheriff's Office conducted 566 sex offender checks monitoring a total of 115 Moore County registered sex offenders. Our Volunteers contributed approximately 1100 hours for the year.

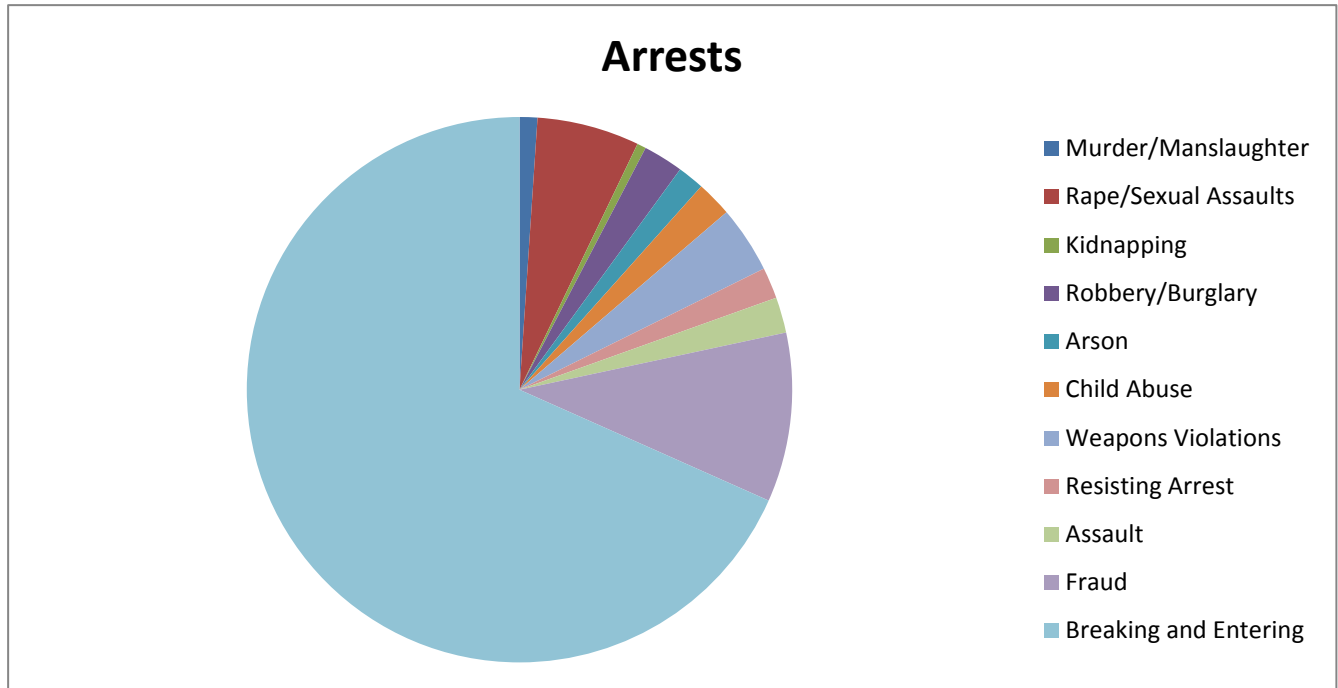

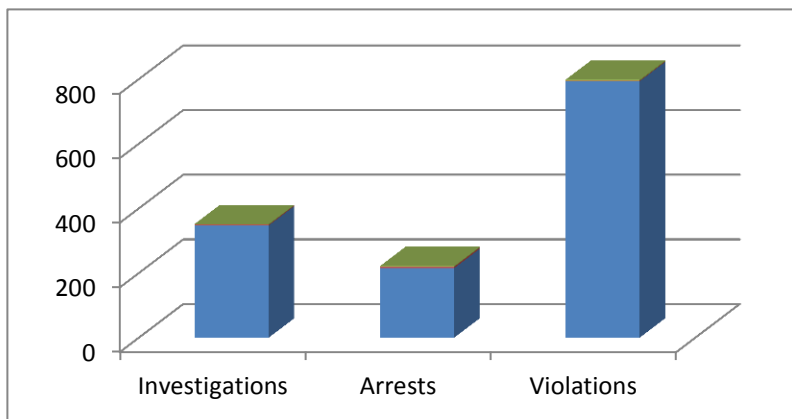
Detectives arrested 429 suspects totaling 872 felony and 158 misdemeanor charges, opened 1222 investigations and recovered \$974,000.58 in stolen property. Arrests included: three for murder, one for manslaughter, 10 for rape, two for kidnapping, five for robbery, 13 for sexual assaults, six for arson, four for burglary, four for safecracking, eight for child abuse, fifteen for weapons violations, three

for stalking, one for the exploitation of the elderly, one for felony hit-and-run, two for chop-shop activity, seven for resisting arrest, eight for assault, 38 for fraud, fourteen for drug violations 259 for breaking and or entering/larceny and 25 for miscellaneous misdemeanor charges.

The Narcotics Division opened 347 investigations and arrested 215 suspects on a total of 793



drug and alcohol violations; 19 suspects were arrested for doctor shopping/prescription fraud. Narcotic Deputies seized: 639 pounds of marijuana, 1,070 grams of methamphetamine, 1,714 dosage units of prescription pills, 232 grams of cocaine, one gram of Hashish, 22 THC Gummy Candies, 156 dosage units of crack-cocaine, 10 dosage units of heroin, 19 bottle of alcohol, seized 23 firearms, 65

grams of MDMA (methylenedioxy-methamphetamine/ Ecstasy/Molly) and \$11,140.00 in US currency; the estimated street value of all drugs seized was approximately \$2,600,685.00. Additionally Deputies conducted 604 ABC store security checks, 238 ABC premise-outlets, inspected and visited 1,268 additional ABC premise-outlets.

In 2016 we issued 3118 pistol purchase permits, totaling 8,565 Moore County citizens with conceal-to-carry permits.
